The first part of the project is to fund a replacement bridge on the US 41 North Access Road, crossing the Elkcam Waterway about .2 mile north of Galway Lane. The second part is to fund a replacement bridge on the US 41 South Access Road, crossing the Elkcam Waterway about .1 mile north of Martin Drive.

Charlotte County Public Works would like to announce a construction project to rebuild the Elkcam Waterway frontage road bridges, located just south of the intersection of US 41 and Harbor Boulevard. The bridges (both the north and south frontage roads) are located in the Charlotte County right-of-way and will be replaced with new concrete bridges with sidewalks. The bridges will be closed from August 1, 2011, to May 1, 2012. The frontage road will remain open for normal traffic outside the bridges.
