Project Title: Stump Pass Dredge and Beach Renourishment

CIP Number: c390404

Project Description: Boaters in the Stump Pass area (Lemon Bay) face inadequate channel depth through the pass. Restoration of the Stump Pass 1980 channel alignment will enable safe navigation between Lemon Bay and the Gulf of Mexico; will generate approximately 800,000 cubic yards of sand to be used for beach renourishment; will help maintain water quality within Lemon Bay; and will provide advanced protection against storm surge. The dredge channel width will vary from approximately 300' to 600'. Spoil will be placed in three beach fills along approximately 3.5 miles of beach on Knight Island, Don Pedro Island, and north of the State park on Manasota Key.
